Zi'-on: build thou the walls of Jê-rû'-sā-lēm.

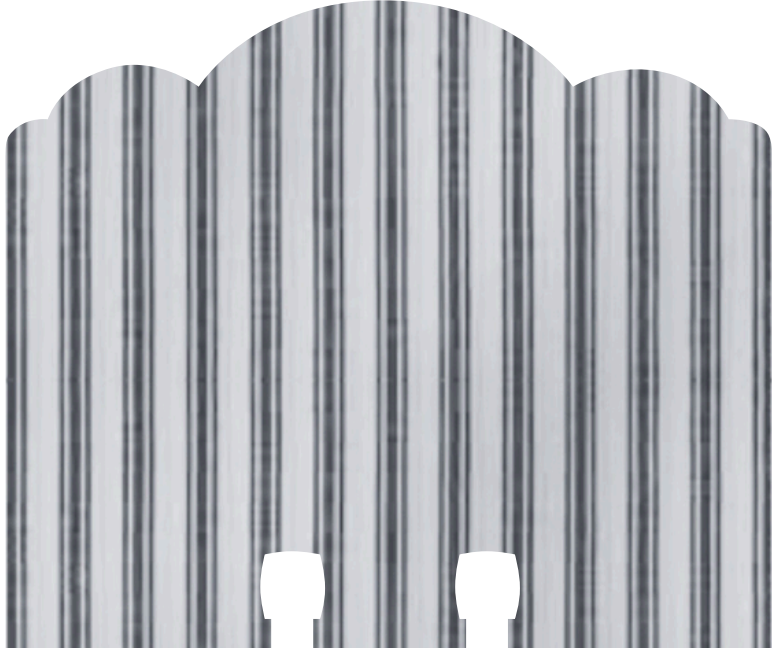
