Key Terms from the Greek

- Blessed (G3107 Makarios):
 - Refers to divine Joy and contentment. To be "blessed" is to be spiritually prosperous, favored by God, and deeply satisfied—regardless of external circumstances. Used 50 times in the New Testament, starting in Matthew 5:3.
- Pure (G2513 Katharos):
 - Means clean, unstained, and free from corruption. Biblically, this purity can be:
 - Physical (e.g., ceremonial cleanliness),
 - MORAL (FREE FROM SIN AND GUILT),
 - Spiritual (sincere, genuine, without mixture),
 - AGRICULTURAL (LIKE A VINE PRUNED TO BEAR FRUIT),
 - REFINED (AS IN GOLD PURIFIED BY FIRE).
- HEART (G2588 KARDIA):
 - REPRESENTS THE CORE OF A PERSON—THOUGHTS,
 DESIRES, EMOTIONS, WILL, AND MORAL CHARACTER. IT
 IS THE CENTER OF BOTH PHYSICAL AND SPIRITUAL LIFE
 AND IS USED 160 TIMES IN THE NT.
- SEE (G3700 OPTANOMAI):
 - To perceive, experience, or behold. It implies not just physical sight but spiritual revelation and relational knowledge. Rooted in Horao—first used in Matthew 2:10 ("When they saw the star, they rejoiced...").

- GOD (G2316 THEOS):
 - REFERS TO THE ONE TRUE GOD—THE TRIUNE GOD
 (FATHER, SON, HOLY SPIRIT), REVEALED THROUGH
 SCRIPTURE AND ESPECIALLY THROUGH JESUS CHRIST
 ("EMMANUEL GOD WITH US," MATTHEW 1:23).

Pure in Heart

 TO BE "PURE IN HEART" MEANS HAVING AN INNER LIFE THAT IS CLEAN, UNDIVIDED, AND FREE FROM HYPOCRISY.
 IT IS NOT SIMPLY ABOUT OUTWARD BEHAVIOR BUT ABOUT INWARD TRANSFORMATION.

• REFINED BY FIRE:

 Just as gold is tested in fire, so are our hearts refined through trials. The intense heat reveals and removes impurities (dross), leaving something valuable and pure behind. (See Malachi 3:2–3, 1 Peter 1:7)

• Pruned Like a Vine:

JESUS SAID THE FATHER IS A GARDENER WHO PRUNES
 FRUITFUL BRANCHES TO MAKE THEM EVEN MORE
 FRUITFUL (JOHN 15:2). PRUNING REMOVES THE
 UNNECESSARY TO STRENGTHEN GROWTH. BEFORE YOU
 BLOOM. YOU MUST BE PRUNED.

• LEVITE-LEVEL PURITY:

 In the Old Testament, being "Clean" was required to enter the temple and worship. This ceremonial purity pointed to the spiritual reality Jesus came to fulfill: true worship starts with a clean heart (Psalm 24:3–4).

Mhy the Heart Matters

In biblical terms, the heart is not just emotions—it's the seat of intellect, will, affections, and character. A pure heart means:

- THOUGHTS ARE ALIGNED WITH TRUTH
- Desires are shaped by holiness
- INTENTIONS ARE SINCERE AND UNDIVIDED
- EMOTIONS ARE SUBMITTED TO GOD
- WILL AND CHARACTER REFLECT GOD'S NATURE

Psalm 51:10 – "Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a right spirit within me."

- This does not refer only to physical sight, but to experiencing God's presence, character, and truth. It implies:
 - RELATIONAL CLOSENESS AN INTIMATE KNOWING
 - SPIRITUAL PERCEPTION DISCERNMENT AND REVELATION
 - ETERNAL VISION A FUTURE HOPE TO BEHOLD HIM FACE TO FACE (REVELATION 22:4)
- In contrast, Ezekiel 39:23–24 shows that impurity causes God to hide His face. When our hearts are unclean, our spiritual vision is clouded. But when we are cleansed, God not only reveals His face—He pours out His Spirit (Ezekiel 39:28–29).

JESUS FLIPS CULTURAL AND RELIGIOUS EXPECTATIONS IN THIS BEATITUDE. IN HIS TIME, PURITY WAS OFTEN SEEN AS EXTERNAL: CEREMONIAL, SOCIAL, OR PHYSICAL. BUT JESUS TEACHES THAT **TRUE PURITY STARTS FROM WITHIN** AND LEADS TO REAL COMMUNION WITH GOD.

THIS ALIGNS WITH THEMES FROM:

- **PSALM 24:3–4** ONLY THOSE WITH CLEAN HANDS AND A PURE HEART MAY ASCEND THE HILL OF THE LORD.
- **Hebrews 12:14** Without Holiness, no one will see the Lord.
- **James 4:8** Draw Near to God, and He will draw Near to you. Purify your hearts.

TRUTHS:

- Blessedness comes through heart purity, not religious performance.
- PURITY IS BOTH A PROCESS (REFINEMENT, PRUNING) AND A POSITION (CLEANSED IN CHRIST).
- TO SEE GOD IS TO EXPERIENCE HIM NOW AND BEHOLD HIM FULLY IN ETERNITY.
- A PURE HEART IS NOT ACHIEVED BY EFFORT ALONE—IT IS A WORK OF GRACE AND PARTNERSHIP WITH THE SPIRIT.


