Children of God Cross Reference

Matthew 5:9 (ESV): "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God."

Cross reference between Matthew 5:9 and John 1:12:

Both verses emphasize the idea of becoming children of God. Matthew 5:9 highlights that peacemakers will be identified as God's children, while John 1:12 explains that those who receive and believe in Christ are given the right to be called His children. This connection reinforces that being part of God's family is not only about belief but also about living in a way that reflects His nature by being a peacemaker. Peacemaking is more than avoiding conflict, it's about bringing God's love, truth, and reconciliation into relationships and situations.

John 1:12 (ESV): "But to all who did receive him, who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God."

Devotional Thought

Belonging is one of the deepest desires of the human heart. In this short but powerful verse in John 1:12, we are reminded that belonging to God is not earned, it is received through faith. By believing in Jesus, we are invited into God's family as His children. This is not temporary or conditional, it is secure, eternal, and freely given. No matter our past, failures, or doubts, when we receive Jesus, we are fully embraced as beloved children. This truth anchors our worth, shapes our purpose, and gives us confidence to live as peacemakers and light-bearers in the world. Being a child of God is a gift, but it also comes with a calling, to be a peacemaker. As we walk in this identity, we become living reflections of our Father, bringing His peace to a world in need.

- I walk confidently knowing I belong to my Heavenly Father.
- God's love defines my worth and purpose.
